# UNVEILING OF COMMEMORATIVE BENCHES MARKING THE CENTENARY OF ARMISTICE DAY ON 11<sup>th</sup> NOVEMBER 1918

Our magnificent new benches to commemorate the Centenary of the Armistice in 1918 were unveiled by the Hon. Tony Abbott MP, Member for Warringah, at a ceremony held in the Cenotaph precinct on Wednesday 4th July.

Mr. Abbott was joined by our 3 Life Members, Bill Hardman OAM, John Finlay and Don Kennedy to complete the unveiling.

The date is significant in that it was the centenary of the Battle of Hamel led by GEN Sir John Monash including US troops under Australian command in their first battle of WWI.




#### **MEMORIAL PATHWAY AND CENOTAPH QR CODES**

Wednesday 4th July saw the culmination of our project to upgrade the Memorial Pathway and Cenotaph with QR code blocks, which provide direct digital access to our website with the historical data of the plaques.
