He also served as our sub-Branch Alternate Delegate at Northern Beaches District Council/NBDC meetings, and as NBDC Secretary/ Treasurer. Jon Black CSC - Guest Speaker - 5th February 2020

We were privileged to have Jon Black CSC, CEO of RSL NSW, as guest speaker at our 5th February meeting. Jon came in response to our request for a speaker to give us an insight into how our \$10,000 donation to the RSL NSW Disaster Assistance Fund is being spent.

In fact, the RSL NSW website has links to exactly what has been contributed and a spreadsheet detailing expenditure. An excellent example of full disclosure. It is worth noting that the Fund covers not only the devastation caused by the bushfires (our trigger for the donation), but also the ongoing drought plaguing our regional members.

However, as part of a 3 month "travelling roadshow", Jon presented and sought feedback on the RSL NSW Strategic Plan 2020-2025. In addition to an introduction on-screen, hard copies were distributed and are available online from the RSL NSW website. Should members require a hard copy, we can provide it for you if you visit the office. This is a great opportunity for us to provide input into the future of RSL NSW.

The presentation was well received and we look forward to another visit by Jon Black CSC.

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

Our RSL NSW CEO, Jon Black CSC, has identified areas in Anzac House where volunteer members could assist with duties on an interim basis. These roles are not envisaged to be ongoing if the Strategic Plan is adopted, when decisions will be made on funding of future organizational roles to deliver agreed outcomes.

The interim Anzac House volunteer roles are:

<u>A protocol officer</u>: to assist the State Secretary discharge his responsibilities around major events and commemorations, and general protocol advice to all sub-Branches (for example: ex-RSMs and equivalents?).

An assistant grants officer: to assist the GM Commercial and Strategy (the role that oversights Hyde Park Inn, fundraising, communications and assists the CEO with strategy). This would include the recently won grant for 'IT for retirees' training, and for the South Coast veterans centre once that agreement is settled.

<u>An assistant for policy/advocacy</u>: to assist with research and prepare the arguments to progress to policymakers (government etc).
