Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> August 2020 marked the 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Victory in the Pacific Day, or VP Day as it now known, when WW11 ended. We remember the tremendous sacrifices made, to support the veterans that returned and to acknowledge that this period of our history was a formative time for our nation.

To commemorate this significant anniversary, DVA has produced a Commemorative Medallion and Certificate of Commemoration, which are available to every living veteran of WW11.
