All new pavers have now been laid. Orders will now be taken for ANZAC Day, closing on Monday 15 March 2021.


Prepaid Pavers:

DEFENCE SERVICE HOMES (DSH) INSURANCE

From 1st January 2020, DSH Insurance has expanded eligibility requirements to now include all current and former members of the Australian Defence Force (ADF) with at least one day of full time service. This means more than 600,000 additional ADF personnel and veterans (including reservists and peacekeepers, as well as widows and widowers of those ADF members) can now access home building insurance regardless of their type or length of service. DSH Insurance is administered by DVA.
