PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Greetings to all!

Our General Meeting on Wednesday 3rd February was a busy one. We welcomed Barry Brown as a transfer-in Service member from Dee Why RSL sub-Branch.

Then, Secretary Vince Williams delivered his comprehensive Secretary's Report, which included three motions for endorsement by members. Firstly, based on my President's Report in the February newsletter as a preamble regarding membership fees for 2021, members present unanimously approved our Committee proposal that subsidising 2021 membership fees is a welfare issue affecting *all* sub-Branch members. The sub-Branch will therefore pay these for *all* members, in a non-discriminatory way, as part of our charitable purpose. This was then confirmed to Bill Hardman, President of Northern Beaches District Council, by the 15th March deadline, as requested by RSL NSW.

Secondly, at the Northern Beaches District Council meeting on Tuesday 19th January, it was agreed that sub-Branches incorporate as soon as possible. Our Committee proposed to incorporate as a Company Limited by Guarantee, providing us with greater legal protection and trustees will no longer be required. We will also be required, as part of this process, to have our company name registered with ASIC: Forestville RSL sub-Branch Ltd. This proposal was unanimously endorsed by members present.

Thirdly, members present unanimously endorsed the Committee's proposal that Peter McAskill JP join our Committee as Membership Officer. Peter was accordingly presented with his Committee tie. Welcome, Peter! It's wonderful to have you on board with us.

We are still however looking to fill the position of Treasurer, a role which is not as onerous now that we have engaged the services of a bookkeeper for a few hours each week. We encourage you to give serious consideration to nominating your services as Treasurer for 2021-2023.

We have our AGM coming up on Wednesday 3rd March in the Forest Room at Forestville RSL Club. We hope as many members as possible will attend. We look forward to seeing you then.

Our sub-Branch will host the Northern Beaches District Council AGM at Forestville RSL Club on Tuesday 16th March at 7.30pm, with Bill Hardman OAM in the chair as President.

Finally, our ANZAC Sunday and ANZAC Day services are subject to COVID-19 rules, which could change. Please refer to the notices in this newsletter.

Please enjoy yourselves as we move into our (hopefully) milder Sydney autumn weather, and call us if you are in need.


At the conclusion, under COVID-19 restrictions, the sub-Branch will be providing complimentary breakfast in the Club Bistro for ticketed attendees.

However, we do not have a program for reaching out to ADF veterans and serving members of the ADF on the Northern Beaches.

Some of you will have heard the presentation by LTCOL Nick de Bont at our GM on 03 Feb. Nick provided excellent examples of how we can reach out effectively. A brief summary of these points is:

- Consider the fact that the younger generation is time poor and especially ADF members who serve in the reserve
- Promotion of contact with nearby units (representatives from HMAS Penguin, 7Bty 9Regt RAA and 2/17 RNSWR attended the meeting)
- Employment promotion of & for retired veterans in our community by establishing contact with local businesses
- Collate data of agencies supporting veterans making the RSL a single point of contact for this information
- Support sporting activities which engage veterans
- Widen the scope to engage the Northern Beaches District Council
- Engage the RSL Club Ltd management to promote welcoming ADF members and providing suitable discounts
- Promote understanding of the difference between the RSL sub-Branch and Club Ltd

Further and in line with our Strategic Plan, establish Wellness Support Officers to work with veterans as a first point of contact to assist with personal issues. As the initiative develops, we will keep you updated and a new website tab will have full information.
