PRESIDENT'S REPORT

We're half way through a very busy 2020 for our Committee members, and our Committee volunteer Sue Duchesne.

Our members at the General Meeting on 2nd June endorsed the nomination of Kevin Leary to join our Committee in the new role of Assistant Secretary. We warmly welcome you, Kevin, and we look forward to you supporting our Secretary, Vince Williams, particularly with the management of our commemorative services, events, meetings and annual lunches etc. Thanks again, Kevin.

On your behalf, we take this opportunity to thank the Committee and members of the RSL Auxiliary. Over the period of our Anzac commemorative services, the RSL Auxiliary was able to raise \$2000, a great result considering the COVID-19 restrictions which were in place. Well done, President Annie Betts, Committee, and RSL Auxiliary members!

The RSL NSW State Congress 2020 will be held in Newcastle 4th to 6th October, attended by Bill Hardman and myself as Delegates, and VP Sandy Howard as Alternate Delegate. As already endorsed by our members, our sub-Branch will have a motion in place at the Congress to make the RSL badge more contemporary, particularly the flowers used which are not representative of Australian flowers, and the service representatives depicted which are now out of date. The RSL brand and badge are among the most highly regarded and respected brands in Australia. Now that RSL NSW is in the process of modernising the organisation to attract new service members under 50, our Committee feels that the RSL badge needs to be updated as part of this process.

We were pleased to see 275 entries from area schools for the Australia My Country competition, after only 210 entries were received due to COVID last year. Judging took place on 29th May. Winners were awarded at the AMC Presentation Ceremony on 26th June at the Club by the Hon. Jonathan O'Dea, BA, LLM, MBA, MP, Speaker of the Legislative Assembly. We thank our Committee Members who co-ordinated the AMC program in 2021 for our sub-Branch: John Balfour OAM, John Scifleet, and Vince Williams CSC, supported by our Committee members. Well done, all! We also thank our Active Committee Volunteer, Darryl Bullock, our resident photographer, for always being available to pictorially record these sub-Branch events and activities.

Our Committee has decided to rename our annual luncheon in August as the Commemoration Luncheon, commemorating three significant August events in our history: The Battle of Amiens on 8th August 1918; Victory in the Pacific Day on 15th August 1945; and The Battle of Long Tan on 18th August 1966 - now Vietnam Veterans Day. This luncheon will be held at the Club on Sunday 15th August and full details are included in this newsletter.

At our December 2020 General Meeting, I reported on Northern Beaches Council plans to upgrade the Forestville Centre shopping precinct, including the Cenotaph which we maintain. In discussions with Council, we have been advised that these plans have been put on hold, awaiting possible grants to support any upgrade, and what form it might take. We will keep you informed as and when further information becomes available.

VALE BOB "BOZO" FULTON AM – RUGBY LEAGUE IMMORTAL

1st December 1947 – 23rd May 2021

"Field no match for time in a war zone" - DERRICK KRUSCHE Daily Telegraph

Bob Fulton first learnt about the importance of discipline when working with Diggers in the Vietnam War. The Manly great was conscripted into the army during the conflict in the 1960s and was put to work as a PE instructor on the aircraft carrier HMAS Sydney. The ship transported Aussie troops into battle.

Fulton, who spent two years in the army, spoke of his admiration for the Diggers, deployed into conflict zones from the HMAS Sydney, while he remained on the ship to continue training. "I did not envy those soldiers getting off the boat, I felt for them, I didn't experience what they went through, they were real tough guys. Think of the toughest footballer you have ever seen. Any soldier who goes to war is tougher than him. Here we are talking about running on to a field to win a State of Origin football game, but compare that with going into a war that would determine whether you lived or died".

Bob Fulton was married to Ann, and is also survived by sons Scott and Brett, and daughter Kristie. The NSW Government accorded him a State Funeral at St Mary's Cathedral on 4th June 2021. A fitting tribute.
