#### **PRESIDENT'S REPORT**

We're half way through a very busy 2022 for our Committee members, and our Committee volunteer Sue Duchesne.

Having given the requisite 30 days notice at our General Meeting on 1<sup>st</sup> June, at our General Meeting on 6<sup>th</sup> July, our members will be asked to endorse our Committee recommendation that Committee member, and Ceremonial Officer, John Balfour OAM, be nominated for a Meritorious Service Medal, the highest honour which can be bestowed on a member. Nominees must be a Life Member, with 30 years continuous League membership, and have given 25 years continuous outstanding service. JB, as he is affectionately known, meets all these criteria.
