March is always a busy month for your Committee with preparations for our Anzac Sunday March and Service on 23rd April, and Anzac Dawn Service on Tuesday 25th April. These are well under way, in conjunction with the Forestville RSL Club. Further details are available in this newsletter. Members are encouraged to spread the word about our two commemoration services with your families, friends, and neighbours. We are keen to increase attendance to pre-COVID levels as quickly as possible.

We are pleased to see more families requesting an RSL Tribute at the funeral of their loved one, as part of our welfare services to members. We continue to receive very positive feedback from families on how memorable and meaningful an RSL Tribute is, to have their service recognised in this way. It is also good to see more of our members attending these funerals as a mark of respect to our mates who have passed on. Our Patron, Don Kennedy OAM, at 96 years of age, attends nearly every funeral. Thanks, Don!

At our AGM on 1st March, our 2020/2023 Committee members were all re-elected unopposed for 2023/2026. Our Committee is cohesive, collegiate, and cooperative. Congratulations to each of our Committee members and, on behalf of all of our members, many thanks for your ongoing Committee service and your commitment to our sub-Branch and our members.

Our sub-Branch hosted the AGM of the Northern Beaches District Council (NBDC) on Tuesday 21st March at Forestville RSL Club. This is an increasingly important part of our overall sub-Branch operations across the Forest area and the Northern Beaches. At this meeting, I was re-elected unopposed as NBDC President and Vince Williams CSC, also our sub-Branch Secretary, was re-elected unopposed as NBDC Secretary. At our sub-Branch Annual General Meeting (AGM) on Wednesday 1st March, we also endorsed myself and Vince Williams CSC as our NBDC Delegates, and Sandy Howard and Ted Samojlowicz as Alternate Delegates. This DPC meeting was followed by a three hour joint DPC and RSL NSW Board meeting. Both were very productive meetings, very much focusing on the RSL NSW Strategic Plan 2021/2026, including all of the elements included in the plan.

We have introduced a monthly sub-Branch walking group on the third Wednesday of each month, with the next walk group to take place on Wednesday 19th April commencing from the entrance of the Forestville RSL Club at 9.45am, followed by morning tea/coffee in the Club. Purple Poppy Day

PURPLE POPPY DAY DOG PERAMBULATION

Since 2019, 24th February each year has been designated as Australia's War Animal Day, to be known as Purple Poppy Day, commemorating the deeds and sacrifices of our war animals serving alongside our troops. On this day, we are all encouraged to wear a purple poppy in remembrance of our four-legged and feathered diggers who also fought and died.

Our commemoration on Thursday 24th February, hosted by our sub-Branch, was a gentle Purple Poppy Dog Perambulation, commencing in the Club carpark at 10am, along the Anzac Memorial Pathway and the Northern Pathway, to the Purple Poppy Dog Park adjacent to the Club, and returning to the Club around 10.45am for morning tea in Pickets. Nearly half of the walkers were our RSL Auxiliary members!

We were delighted that our Northern Beaches Council Mayor, and local Councillor, Michael Regan, was able to join us, to unveil the one of the three new signs Council has erected at the Purple Poppy Dog Park, commemorating Animals in War with a description of the Canine Operational Service Medal and including an image of the medal. Thanks, Mayor Regan.

The naming of the Purple Poppy Dog Park was approved by Northern Beaches Council in November 2022, following a request from our sub-Branch earlier in the year, as our contribution to the commemoration of War Animal Day. The Purple Poppy Dog Park off-leash dog area is of course part of the Forestville War Memorial Playing Fields, which are so much part of our sub-Branch history
