## PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Our Committee members have settled back in to more normal office operations, after our very successful Anzac commemorative services in April.

On Anzac Sunday there were around 150 in marching groups, and around 750 attended the Service itself. The March route was lined with residents and well-wishers. At the Dawn Service, there were around 1000 in attendance, with a majority of younger families including young children. Following the Service, breakfast was served for 521 attendees in 75 minutes from 6.15am.

On behalf of our Committee and members, I thank Club CEO, Ian Thomson, his management team and all Club staff, as well as Adison "Edi" Wang and his kitchen brigade, for all of the wonderful support, cooperation and assistance, over what was a very busy and long Anzac weekend, in more ways than one!

Darryl Bullock, our sub-Branch member and very professional resident photographer, took photos at the Dawn Service, a selection of which is included in this newsletter. A larger selection of Darryl's photos for both services are available on our sub-Branch website for your perusal, under the Events/Gallery tab. Our thanks again, Darryl, as always! Great job!

A few "gremlins" found their way into our wireless sound system used for both services, with a few issues experienced during the Dawn Service, when attendees were around the entrance to the Club, which coincidentally had an immediate effect on our wireless system. We are now pursuing a hard-wired system for Remembrance Day and our Anzac services next year.

Australia My Country judging took place on 27<sup>th</sup> May at the Forestville RSL Club. Winners will be awarded at our AMC Presentation Ceremony on 17<sup>th</sup> June at the Club. Michael Regan MP, Independent Member for Wakehurst, has been invited to present the awards.

On Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> June, Committee and sub-Branch members will attend the 81st Defence of Sydney Commemoration Service at North Head organized by the Australia Remembers - Northern Beaches and North Shore - Committee. This Service commemorates the 81st Anniversary of the night that "war came to Sydney" with the Japanese midget submarine attack on Sydney Harbour on the night of 31st May 1942. Our sub-Branch will lay a wreath. The Guest Speaker will be Commodore Raymond Leggatt, AM, CSC, RAN – Deputy Fleet Commander.

On your behalf, we congratulate our RSL Auxiliary members who participated in fundraising activities on Anzac Sunday and Anzac Day, which resulted in \$3425 being raised, an outstanding achievement. So far this year, \$6454 has been raised, so our congratulations to all RSL Auxiliary members involved.

Our sub-Branch 70<sup>th</sup> Anniversary will occur in 2024. Should any members have original photos depicting the construction of the Soldiers' Memorial Hall on Starkey Street, or the early stages of building the Club on Melwood Avenue, and you are happy to share them, please drop them into the sub-Branch office during office hours.


