### PRESIDENT'S REPORT

July has been another busy period for the sub-Branch Committee. On Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> July, Vice President Sandy Howard, Secretary Vince Williams, and I attended the Northern Beaches District Council meeting at Pittwater RSL Club.

I had also earlier attended a District Presidents Council (DPC) Meeting in Anzac House on Friday 30<sup>th</sup> June. I provided a report on that meeting to members at our General Meeting on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> July. A significant outcome is that you would have received an email in early July from RSL NSW letting you know that SOP1, *Funding Our Charitable Purpose*, has now been approved by the DPC and the RSL NSW Board. All sub-Branches, and RSL NSW, can now move forward with the Veteran Support Fund (VSF) as our key focus for supporting veterans and their families. This will ensure our collective activities are carried out in the name of RSL NSW to make all communities in NSW aware of the RSL NSW link to all activities funded by sub-Branches. This will strengthen RSL NSW branding, which in the past received little or no recognition.

At the DPC meeting, RSL NSW also shared with us 2021 Census data for our 10 sub-Branches across the Northern Beaches, comparing current membership numbers against ADF Ever Served data from the census. This will now be used for a "30 by 2030" goal for our Northern Beaches sub-Branches to have 30% of ADF Ever Served members in their respective catchment areas as members of a sub-Branch by 2030. Fortunately for us, and across the Northern Beaches, we are already well on our way to achieving this goal, which forms part of the RSL NSW Strategic Plan 2021/2026.

There was also discussion on sub-Branch Incorporation as a Company Limited by Guarantee (CLG), which our Committee is planning to achieve by 2026. The option for smaller sub-Branches to Incorporate as an Association is being explored by the RSL NSW CEO and Board, however there is concern that this model currently does not have provision for protection of assets.

Ticket sales for our Commemoration Luncheon on Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> August have been bubbling along, we thank you for your support. At this luncheon, we will commemorate wars, conflicts and battles which occurred over the period of July, August, September. Booking, payment (EFTPOS is available) and cancellation details are included in this newsletter. Please book soon if you have not already done so, the cut-off is Thursday 3rd August. Please note that cancellations are non-refundable after Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> August.

Our RSL Auxiliary monthly luncheon on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> August will not be a regular meeting. It will be a working bee to make poppies in readiness for fundraising around Remembrance Day. Auxiliary members will be crocheting, knitting, and sewing various forms of poppies. Demand is very strong in the community for hand-made poppies, so we encourage each of you to support our RSL Auxiliary members when they are selling poppies. The funds they raise will support the welfare of veterans and their families, especially those in need, as part of our charitable purpose.

The ACCC has a handy website called ScamWatch, which provides up to date information on recent scams, reporting of scams, and getting help if you've been scammed. 
