PRESIDENT'S REPORT

On your behalf, I thank our energetic and extremely hard-working Committee members and Committee volunteers for what has been another busy month. We have a caring, well-oiled, progressive and industrious Committee, always with your interests at the forefront. Tuesday 15th August 2023 marked the 78th Anniversary of VP Day, the end of WW11. 70 members and guests attended our Commemoration Luncheon on Sunday 13th August, commemorating all Wars, Campaigns and Battles in July, August and September. It was a very successful luncheon, with thanks to all who attended.

On Thursday 3rd August Northern Beaches District Council (NBDC) held a very successful Vietnam Veterans' Vigil at Frenchs Forest Bushland Cemetery, commemorating three Vietnam Veterans buried there, who were KIA or died for health reasons in Vietnam. On Friday 18th August, I represented our sub-Branch, and NBDC, at the Vietnam Veterans' Day 2023 Commemoration Service at the War Memorial on Manly Corso. That afternoon, NBDC held a Vietnam Veterans' Day Commemoration Service in the Chapel at War Vets Village at Narrabeen, hosted by War Vets Village RSL sub-Branch. Then, on Sunday 20th August, Palm Beach RSL sub-Branch organized an NBDC march, service, and luncheon, where I was Guest Speaker.

ATTENTION: VIETNAM VETERANS SILENT BURDEN: AN INTERVIEW AND PORTRAIT SESSION

CONGRESSIONAL GOLD MEDAL

The Congressional Gold Medal is the highest honour bestowed by the U.S. Congress, recognizing those whose dedication, heroism, and public service have created an impact on American history. Don Kennedy OAM was a member of the U.S. Merchant Marine between 7th December 1941 and 31st December 1946, which qualifies him for this prestigious award. Congratulations, Don!
