CONSULATE GENERAL OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA CEREMONY OF HONOUR FOR DON E. KENNEDY OAM

RECIPIENT OF THE MERCHANT MARINERS OF WWII CONGRESSIONAL GOLD MEDAL Friday 2nd February, 2024
United States Consulate, North Sydney

Along with Don's wife of 65 years, Wynne, and family members, attendees included RSL NSW President Mick Bainbridge, RSL NSW Board Director Paul James, and RSL NSW State Secretary Jeff O'Brien. Our sub-Branch President, Bob Lunnon and his wife Barbara, represented our sub-Branch and Northern Beaches District Council.

The United States Consul General, Christine Elder, presented Don with his Congressional Gold Medal, awarded to Merchant Mariners of WWII, part of the US Army. Don served with the Merchant Mariners ending in Shanghai.

International recipients of the Congressional Gold Medal include Queen Beatrix of the Netherlands, Sir Winston Churchill, Mother Theresa, Nelson Mandela, Pope John Paul II, Dalai Lama, Shimon Perez and Anwar Sadat.
