As usual April has been a very busy month for your Committee members including attendance at Anzac services at Forestville Public School, John Colet School in Belrose, and Belrose Country Club. Sub-Branch representatives also attended RSL commemorative services and laid wreaths at: RSL Anzac Village March and Service in Narrabeen, Kokoda Track Memorial Walkway, Merchant Navy Memorial and Columbarium at Rookwood, Terrey Hills Community Service, Palm Beach RSL sub-Branch March and Service, Manly Oval Anzac Day Rugby, and Collaroy RSL sub-Branch Sunset Service.

Our own Anzac services on Anzac Sunday 21st April and Dawn Service on 25th April were very successful and well attended. Our thanks to those hardy volunteers for their help in placing chairs for seating, plus other duties. Special mention of the diligent and hard work behind the scenes goes to Vince Williams CSC, our Secretary, and Assistant Secretary, Kevin Leary, supported by Committee members and volunteers.

Thanks also to our RSL Auxiliary members for their assistance, including fund-raising for the RSL NSW Veterans Support Fund over the Anzac period, and serving tea/coffee to all attendees after our Anzac Dawn Service.

The Australia Remembers – Northern Beaches and North Shore Committee is organizing a Defence of Sydney 82nd Commemorative Service at 10am on Friday 7th June at North Head, open to members and the public. This service commemorates the Japanese midget submarine attack on Sydney Harbour on the night of 31st May 1942. Your sub-Branch representatives on this organizing committee are Sandy Howard, Vice President, and me as President of RSL NSW Northern Beaches District Council (NBDC).

The AGM of our NBDC, hosted by our sub-Branch, will be held at Forestville RSL Club on Tuesday 21st May at 6.30pm for 7pm. I will also attend the next meeting of the RSL NSW District President's Council (DPC) on Thursday 23rd May at Anzac House when we will consider and approve 2025 nominations of charities for inclusion in the RSL NSW Veterans Support Fund.
